

Reading

The Global Scale of English is transforming English teaching and learning, offering a granular, real-world measure of English language proficiency across the four skills. Some examples of what a learner can do in Reading on the GSE scale:



Can **read and understand simple prices**



Can **understand simple technical information** (e.g. instructions for everyday equipment)



Can **recognise the writer's point of view** in a structured text



Can **understand complex arguments** in newspaper articles



Can **understand short written notices, signs and instructions** with visual support



Can **identify the main topic and related ideas** in a structured text



Can **recognise the repetition of ideas expressed** by substitution, paraphrasing, etc



Can **understand highly colloquial language in unstructured texts** that use complex structures
